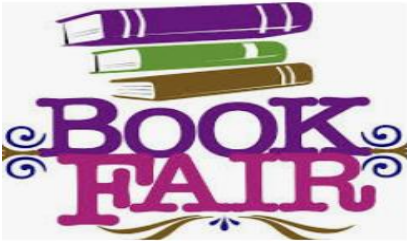

Thank you to our SAA community who volunteered their time, shared their talents, sponsored, and came out on a rainy Saturday to make Homecoming a success.

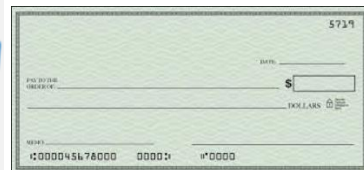
