Family Bowling Night at Sproul Lanes--Sponsored by 8th Grade

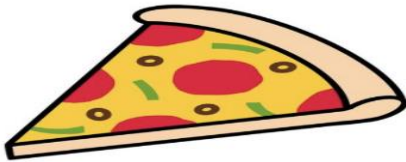

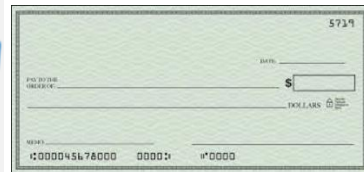

Pennsylvania state law (Act 153 of 2014) requires volunteers have clearances on school file. All volunteers are required to submit clearances to Sister Margaret at sistermargaretf@stalloysiusacademy.org

Required Clearances for Volunteers

The following clearances must be obtained by volunteers living in PA for less than 10 years:

- Federal Bureau of Investigation Fingerprint Clearance
- Pennsylvania State Police Clearance
- Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance

The following clearances must be obtained by volunteers living in PA continuously for 10 years:

- Pennsylvania State Police Clearance
- Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance
- Disclosure Statement application for volunteers to be filed at the place of service

For all current and/or prospective volunteers use **code 1KG6ZJ** for Pennsylvania Department of Education(PDE) Volunteers

After above code is entered you should then click on Schedule or Manage appointment and enter the required information

This process needs to be completed/updated every 5 years for compliance.

Volunteers who have been a resident of Pennsylvania for less than 10 years must renew their FBI Fingerprint clearance every year until they reach 10 years of residency in Pennsylvania. Once the volunteer meets the 10 year residency

requirement, they must complete a Disclosure Statement Application for Volunteers which must be submitted every five years.

Additional Training for Volunteers

OCYP offers training programs for volunteers on child sexual abuse prevention and mandated reporting. These trainings include information on recognizing child abuse, reporting, and handling the disclosure of a child. These training programs are mandatory for volunteers who have regular contact with children. Additionally, the OCYP has created training programs and resources on a range of topics related to child sexual abuse prevention to provide for continued education around these topics.
